Eight of the nine (89%) school districts (Excluding Lincoln-Woodstock) have been significantly impacted by the North Country Charter Academy. The decreases in cumulative dropouts and dropout rates are a direct result of the charter academy. Those districts receiving the greatest impact are Groveton High School which went from having eleven dropouts in 2003-2004 to having only one in 2005-2006, White Mountains Regional High School which went from sixteen dropouts in 2003-2004 to having only six in 2005-2006 and Profile High School which went from having eight dropouts in 2003-2004 to having only two in 2005-2006. These results demonstrate the strong need for North Country Charter Academy.
